Your offer should clearly indicate and include:

1. Unit Cost Per items in US Dollars Currency
2. Tax Clearance Documents from Puntland Authority in 2020
3. Valid Business License (Certificate of the Ministry of Commerce)
4. Puntland National Tender Board (PNTB) registration
5. Validity Period of the Quote/ the offer:
6. Lead time;
7. Terms of Payment: to be paid after delivery in full specifications to be ordered
8. Relevant experience in WASH supplies (contracts or recommendation) from three former clients.
9. Companies should drop sealed hard copy bids to the tender box in WV office in Garowe

Information to bidders:

1. Currency of offer should preferably be in US Dollars Currency
2. Payment will be made to the supplier by check or bank transfer within 30 days from receipt by World Vision Puntland, Garowe office.
3. World vision Somalia will not be responsible for any bank service charges.
4. Inspection (at buyer's expense or unless negotiated as seller's expense) may be applicable and will be advised at time of purchase order and arranged by World vision Somalia or the supplier.
5. World vision Somalia does not undertake to pay by letter of credit or in advance of delivery.
6. World vision Somalia reserves the right to accept the whole or part of your offer.
7. World vision Somalia not responsible for any taxes or levies.
8. Hand-written, incomplete offers or offers which do not comply with any of our tender conditions will not be considered.
9. When applied - There will be liquidated damages equivalent to a deduction of 0.1% per day or part thereof for late deliveries due to default on the part of the suppliers.
10. Guarantee against anti-personnel mines: World vision Somalia has decided to support an international ban on anti-personnel mines. Anti-personnel mines have killed and maimed and continue to kill and maim many refugees. A high proportion of these innocent victims are women and children. These mines pose a serious obstacle to the return of millions of refugees and displaced people around the world. World vision Somalia shall therefore not knowingly buy products from companies that sell or manufacture anti-personnel mines or their components. If you submit a bid based on this request, it shall constitute a guarantee that neither your company nor any affiliate or a subsidiary controlled by your company sell or manufactures anti-personnel mines or their components. A contract clause confirming this will be included in an eventual purchase order based on this request.
11. Environmental policy: World vision Somalia policy is to purchase products and services, which have the least negative impact on the environment. Environmental considerations covering manufacture, transport, packing, use and disposal of goods form part of World vision Somalia evaluation and selection criteria.
12. Terrorists: World vision Somalia will not do any business with any known terrorist group or company involved in anyway with terrorists. World vision Somalia shall therefore not knowingly purchase goods or services from companies that are involved with terrorist groups in any form.
