**Mustaqbal Development and Relief Organization (MUDRO)** is a humanitarian, non-partisan, and non-profit organization established under the laws of Somalia. With its registered office in Mogadishu, MUDRO operates across the Southwest, Jubaland, Galmudug, and Hirshabelle states of Somalia.

MUDRO invites qualified companies/Candidates to submit **bids for the Vehicle hire for project implementation and field activities and Ambulance hire for referrals in Diinsoor**, as outlined in the attached Technical Specifications.

**Submission Deadline:**

All bids must be submitted via **Physical at MUDRO Office next to Laanta Fatxurahman at Howlwadag village in Diinsoor** no later than **23-Aug-2025**.

**1. Eligibility Criteria:**

To be considered for this tender, companies must meet the following criteria:

- a. **Legal Compliance:** Possess the necessary permissions or licenses to conduct business in accordance with local regulations.
- b. **Technical Capability:** Demonstrate relevant experience, technical expertise, and have qualified personnel for project delivery.
- c. **Local Presence:** Be based in Somalia.
- d. **Financial Stability:** Show financial and economic stability to ensure project delivery.
- e. **No Exclusions:** Not be subject to exclusion for any reasons listed in the attached Candidate's Declaration.

**2. Formal Requirements:**

The following documents must be included with the Bid Submission Form:

- b. Candidate's Declaration
- c. Technical Specifications.
- d. Certificate of Registration.
- e. References of previous similar projects

These documents are collectively referred to as the "Tender Documents."

**3. Submission Instructions:**

- a) **Preparation:**

- Complete the attached Bid Submission Form.
  - Prepare the bid in English.
  - Ensure all pages are signed and numbered; pages requiring signatures should be signed, and others initialed/stamped.
- b) Submission:**
- Submit the bid **Physically at MUDRO Office next to Laanta Fatxurahman at Howlwadag village in Diinsoor .**
- c) Expenses:**
- MUDRO will not cover any costs incurred in preparing the bid, regardless of the outcome or potential cancellation of the tender.
- d) Deadline:**
- Late submissions will not be considered.
- e) Bid Amounts:**
- Write bid amounts in both numbers and words. In case of discrepancies, the written amount in words will prevail. Significant discrepancies may lead to bid rejection.
- f) Site Visit:**
- Bidders must visit the site at their own expense to gather necessary information for bid pricing and contract preparation.

- Bids will be opened after the submission deadline.
- b) Evaluation Criteria:**

- 2. Selection Criteria:**
- I. Price – Quality Ratio: 50%
  - II. Contractual Delivery Time: 10%
  - III. Guarantee Conditions: 10%
  - IV. Experience in Similar Projects: 20%
  - V. Active Bank Statement: 10%
- c) Process:** The evaluation will be in two stages: initial formal requirements review followed by a detailed substantive assessment.
- d) Award Decision:** The successful bid will be selected within 10 days after bid opening.

**6. Winning Bidder Obligations:**

Any bidder may file a written appeal regarding any breaches in the tender process with the Chairperson of the Tender Commission within 4 days of receiving a Letter of Rejection.
